

MINUTES OF THE EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF LLANFAELOG COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD AT THE LLANFAELOG VILLAGE HALL AT 6.30pm ON WEDNESDAY 20 FEBRUARY 2019.

1 ABERFFRAW FOOTBALL CLUB

1.1. The meeting was arranged specifically to discuss an urgent request from the football club for a lease of no less than 21 years.

1.2 Following the Charitable Trust meeting of last week the Football Club have been shortlisted into the next round for funding. If successful they would be investing in the region of £60,000 in Cae Cynlas. This investment would include new fit for purpose changing rooms as the present ones have reached the end of their life and a 50-seat stand. They also have it in mind to start a youth team in the near future.

However the Trust has questioned the duration of the lease and asked whether this agreement could be extended to 21 years. If not the club would need to come up with a plan that would mean relocating the club.

The Charitable Trust was due to meet again in March and required a response from the Football Club by Friday 22 February.

1.3 The terms of the agreement had been discussed in detail by the Community Council recently and it was not intended to alter those terms, however members wanted to be certain that it was fit for purpose over the extended period.

1.4 Members:

- examined the wording of the agreement,
- took into account that the Club assists with the up keep of the ground,
- considered the fact that the players come from a wider community (not just Aberffraw) and that the Club is hoping to set up a youth team,
- considered how few other amenities there were in the area,
- reflected on the pleasure the Football Club brings to residents young and old

It was unanimously agreed to extend the current agreement for 21 years from 1st March 2019.

The clerk would notify the Club and prepare the documentation as soon as possible.
